



School Reopening Plans

Several weeks ago, the division established a reopening workgroup to develop contingency plans in preparation for the release of state guidance. Based on preliminary guidance, we know these plans will include a variety of details requiring different schedules and social distancing behaviors while students are on campus.

Finalization of these plans are dependent on the governor’s release of his schools plan. The workgroup’s recommendations will be presented to the superintendent and School Board later this month and will be released publically at that time.

Technology Survey

Last week, the division emailed all families in grades PK-11 a survey regarding a 1:1 technology plan that will support students having equitable access to devices for school and home use.
