Registration

The division's online Student Information Pre-Registration form, yorkcountyschools.org/StudentRegistration, is the first step in the registration process. The form allows parents to save time by inputting their information directly into the division's student management system. Once the online form is submitted, parents will complete the registration in person, which takes place at the school during normal business hours. Parents are encouraged to call and schedule appointments, and to begin the process early, even if all four required documents are not readily available.

Any documents not available must be presented prior to the first day of school.
