Gloucester County Public Schools https://gets.gc.k12.va.us/gifted-education-governors-schools	K-5 gifted students are clustered together and receive pull-out services in home schools several days a week, by a gifted teacher. The gifted teacher plans and coaches gifted cluster teachers. A large number of classroom teachers are gifted endorsed.		
Hampton City Schools http://www.hampton.k12.va.us/departments/gifted/gifted.html	K-2 students are provided a "Talent Pool" program in home schools and re-evaluated at the end of 2 nd grade. Grade 3-5 placement in zoned school resource classes or placed at Spratley Gifted Center, a full-time program.		
Newport News Public Schools http://sbo.nn.k12.va.us/gifted/	Each school has a K-2 TAG program, with pull out services for 30-60 minutes per day. Students in grades 3-5 attend a full time gifted classrooms in zoned school sites. Some sites include students that are not gifted, but selected by administration.		
Norfolk Public Schools https://www.npsk12.com/Page/10000	1 st through 5 th graders are clustered together and provided gifted services for reading and/or math by a push-in/pull-out model. Services are in home schools and delivered by a gifted teacher.		
Poquoson City Schools https://www.poquoson.k12.va.us/Page/10311	At the K-2 primary school, 1 st graders are provided 25 minutes daily for writing enrichment. 2 nd graders are provided daily literacy gifted services. 3 rd -5 th graders receive all of their literacy and math instruction daily, by a gifted teacher.

Identified 3 rd -5 th graders receive QUEST program in home schools once a week in pull-out groups and periodic push-in instruction, both delivered by a gifted teacher.

K-1 students are provided pull-out services once a week. 2 nd -5 th graders are clustered together and provided pull-out/push-in services daily. Gifted students may choose to apply to Old Donation School, a full-time gifted program.		
Williamsburg-James City County Schools https://wiccschools.org/academics/gifted-education/	K-2 students receive pull-out and push-in gifted instruction once a week in home schools. 3 rd -4 th graders receive gifted services in home schools multiple days a week. 5 th graders are instructed in home schools by a gifted teacher for all literacy and math instruction daily.		
York County School Division https://yorkcountyschools.org/parents/specialtyPrograms/giftedEducation.aspx	1 st through 5 th grade students travel from home schools one day a week to the EXTEND center for units of study activities. 1 st graders attend the center for approx. 2 hours and 2 nd -5 th graders attend 5 hours, including lunch and recess. Students are clustered together in home schools and provided differentiated instruction by classroom teachers.
