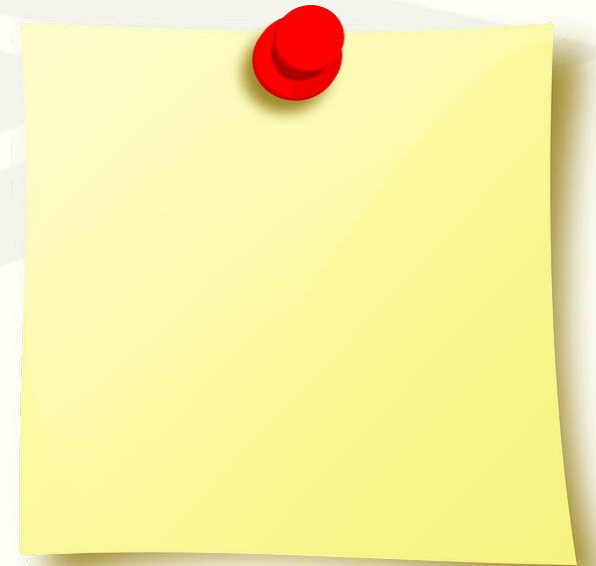

# Surrounding School Divisions' Models

- Gloucester County Public Schools
- Suffolk Public Schools

School Division	Model Description	Website
York County School Division	1 <sup>st</sup> through 5 <sup>th</sup> grade students travel from home schools one day a week to the EXTEND center for units of study activities. 1 <sup>st</sup> graders attend the center for approx. 2 hours and 2 <sup>nd</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> graders attend 5 hours, including lunch and recess. Hampton City Schools	The Gifted Resource Program provides educational opportunities with gifted resource staff on a weekly pullout basis in home schools. K-2 students are provided a "Talent Pool" program and re-evaluated at the end of 2 <sup>nd</sup> grade. Newport News Public Schools	Each school has a K-2 TAG program, with pull out services for 30-60 minutes per day. Students in grades 3-5 attend a full time gifted classrooms in zoned school sites. Poquoson City Schools	At the K-2 primary school, 1 <sup>st</sup> graders are provided 25 minutes daily for writing enrichment. 2 <sup>nd</sup> graders are provided daily literacy gifted services. 3 <sup>rd</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> graders receive all of their literacy and math instruction daily, by a gifted teacher.	<a href="https://www.poquoson.k12.va.us/Page/10311">https://www.poquoson.k12.va.us/Page/10311</a>
Williamsburg-James City County Schools	K-2 students receive pull-out and push-in gifted instruction once a week in home schools. 3 <sup>rd</sup> -4 <sup>th</sup> graders receive gifted services multiple days a week. 5 <sup>th</sup> graders are instructed by a gifted teacher for all literacy and math instruction daily.	<a href="https://wiccschools.org/academics/gifted-education/">https://wiccschools.org/academics/gifted-education/</a>
Gloucester County Public Schools	K-5 gifted students are clustered together and receive pull-out services in home schools several days a week, by a gifted teacher. The gifted teacher plans and coaches gifted cluster teachers. Virginia Beach Public Schools	Each school has a full time gifted teacher. K-1 students are provided pull-out services once a week. 2 <sup>nd</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> graders are clustered together and provided pull-out/push-in services daily. Norfolk Public Schools	1 <sup>st</sup> through 5 <sup>th</sup> graders are clustered together and provided gifted services for reading and/or math by a push-in/pull-out model. Services are in home schools and delivered by a gifted teacher.	<a href="https://www.npsk12.com/Page/10000">https://www.npsk12.com/Page/10000</a>
Suffolk Public Schools	An enrichment program serves <i>potentially gifted</i> K-2 students at home schools by a gifted teacher.
