Event Rules and Team Information

Team & Competition Rules:

Teams can consist of no more than 6 people, and all team members must be 18 years of age or older by April 13, 2019. **(proof of age will be required)**

All participants must have a signed waiver before competing.

No team member substitutions may be made after sign-in the day of competition.

Teams will be timed pulling the bus across a 50-foot finish line.

The starting judge will say "Ready, Set" and then blow a horn. Pulling may begin at sound of horn.

The finish line judge will clock the official time when the rear of the bus crosses the finish line. The ruling of the judges stands.

A 30-foot tow rope will be used to pull the bus:

Teams may not attach anything to the rope.

Teams may station their pullers on the rope in any order but may not tie or wrap the rope around any puller.

Before the pull, rope must be held in one hand and down to your side until the horn blows.

Teams may be disqualified for false starts or for violating pull rules.

Should there be a tie, there will be a pull-off to determine the winner.

Participants are encouraged to wear loose fitting clothing, sneakers, and gloves for hand protection. CLOSED TOE SHOES REQUIRED.

Additional Pulls:

Practice pulls can take place before the competition from 10-11 a.m. for a donation of \$15.

Any team wanting to improve their time with an additional pull may do so at designated time for a donation of \$20.

**Team must be comprised of all original members.*

Event Information:

Teams will be assigned pull times between 11 am and 2 pm. It is the team's responsibility to be in place for their scheduled pull time or risk disqualification.

Pull times will be listed on the leader board after each competition.

Awards ceremony will take place immediately following the close of the competition.

How to make your day more fun: Encourage your team to develop a theme, costume, skit, signs, mascot, or musical performance. Bring your family and friends!

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams. There will also be various team spirit awards (examples include best team name, costumes, loudest cheer sections).

**Rain date will be Sunday, April 14, practice pull and registration will begin at 1 p.m.*
